ALL: A Scout is LOYAL

LEADER: Help others and show the spirit of Good Turn

ALL: A Scout is HELPFUL

LEADER: Accept others, without restrictions, for who they are.

ALL: A Scout is FRIENDLY.

LEADER: Courtesy is the mark of all faiths. It is shown in thoughtful acts and kindly respect for everyone.

ALL: A Scout is COURTEOUS.

LEADER: Kindness is the way people show respect for others.

ALL: A Scout is KIND.

LEADER: Life is filled with things that we must do whether we like to do them or not. One of the marks of growing up is our readiness to accept responsibility willingly.

ALL: A Scout is **OBEDIENT.**

LEADER: Our mood makes our day. If we are grouchy, then our day is gloomy. If we are happy, our day is always happier.

ALL: A Scout is CHEERFUL.

LEADER: The world offers many gifts. A wise person uses them with care.

ALL: A Scout is THRIFTY.

LEADER: To each of us comes danger, difficulty tasks, and temptations, in choosing courage or cowardice, may we be brave.

ALL: A Scout is BRAVE.

LEADER: Cleanliness is next to Godliness, to have a clean body, a clean mind, and a clean record is an achievement.
