

Stay Connected with Troop 173

We know that it can be overwhelming during these trying times and many people are suffering from "information overload". With so much information being received from so many different sources, Troop 173 wants to simplify things as much as possible for our Scouts and families. Below are some tips and tricks to help provide a stress-free Scouting experience, while staying up to date on troop activities, events, and advancement opportunities.

Instructions for Joining Virtual Meetings

In order to simplify the process for joining virtual meetings or events, all join links are now located on the calendar section of our website: <u>www.troop173-</u> <u>yorktown.org/calendar</u>. Once on the calendar, select the virtual meeting/event you want to join, and then click "more details".

You will then see the link or instructions on how to join the meeting. Any meeting agendas or documents will also be included as an attachment in the calendar details.

For safety reasons, please note that you MUST include your first and last name prior to joining in order for the host to admit you. If your full name is not listed or it is an unrecognizable username (I.e "iPhone" or "metsfan_14") you will not be allowed in until you change that to your full name. Thank you for your understanding.

Additionally, any adult leader with a Troop 173 account (email ending in @troop173yorktown.org) can schedule or start a Google Meet videoconference. We encourage patrol leaders to schedule their own patrol video conference meetings by requesting an adult leader set one up for them. This can also be done to work on advancement, a Scoutmaster Conference, Board of Review, etc.

Sync the Troop 173 Calendar with Your Own Calendar

Troop 173's calendar is frequently updated and you can sync the calendar with your own calendar provider so you never miss a beat, and can easily get reminders on your computer or smartphone. Our calendar is powered by Google Calendar and is posted on our website at www.troop173-yorktown.org/calendar. Click the "+ Google Calendar" button in the bottom right corner to open the calendar in Google and begin to sync.

You can sync the calendar with your own calendar regardless of whether you have a Google calendar account, and you can use other services such as iPhone/iCloud Calendar, Outlook, Microsoft, etc.

Connect with Scoutbook

We will be increasingly reliant on Scoutbook for helping scouts, leaders and parents keep track of advancement requirements during this time.

<u>Scoutbook</u> is an online tool that you and your scouts can use to help manage their scouting careers. Scoutbook serves as an online version of each scout's physical scout book, and each scout or parent can use it to help track advancement, merit badge progress, maintain logs for camping/hiking/service hours, and track leadership positions/tenure.

In order to use Scoutbook, each parent received an "invite to connect" which contained instructions for setting up your account. This would have occurred when we first set up Scoutbook, or when your scout joined our Troop. If any parent needs a new invite, please contact a troop admin.

Parents, once connected, can invite their scout to connect as well. This process can *only* be done by a parent.
